Montana Teen Driver Education Curriculum - New Digital Assets Feature

The traffic education curriculum modules distributed by the Office of Public Instruction meet the Montana traffic education standards and benchmarks described in the *Curriculum Guide for Teen Driver Education and Training*. Refer to the **Curriculum Modules Guide** for a description of all curriculum modules and how to integrate with behind-the-wheel instruction.

Updates: In early 2018, all curriculum files were updated and modules were moved to a new Digital Assets page (see below). This allows for easier access and download. Factsheets with related worksheets are combined into one file. The Lesson Plans have been removed; we recommend using the PDF versions of the Powerpoint files for presenter notes or view them in your Powerpoint program.

Video Playback: All videos that are part of the curriculum presentations are in MP4 format and accessible via the **OPI Traffic Education YouTube** channel. These videos will also play back in the pdf version of the presentation, but MUST be downloaded to your computer. However, any animations created as part of the Powerpoint file will NOT play in the pdf. Videos with audio are closed captioned.
