DRIVER EDUCATORS has information for new and current traffic education teachers, how to get and maintain approval to teach traffic education in Montana, links to traffic education teacher training offered at Montana State University-Northern, and more information about CDTP certification. There is also information about the Montana Traffic Education Association and the annual OPI/MTEA conference held each spring.
